Information for incoming exchange students

To help you choose suitable courses please read the course descriptions in this booklet carefully.

NB: Some courses are taught in French, others in English; the language is indicated in the course description.

Please take note of the following points:

Langue

- Language classes from semesters 1 to 5 comprise both grammar and translation. The translation component is predominantly from English to French and for that reason **we do not advise international students to take these courses.**
- In semester 6 we offer a number of different language options. Students may choose TWO options from a total of six courses (*langue 6.1* to *langue 6.2*).

Phonétique

- Please note that the phonetics courses in 2nd and 3rd year (semesters 3-6) require knowledge of the phonetic alphabet.
- The second-year course *HEA 401B Phonologie* is NOT open to incoming exchange students.

Culture

- The 1st year *civilisation* courses (semesters 1-2) are basic introductions to the USA and to the UK and as such are not suitable for exchange students in their 2nd and 3rd years. In particular, they are not open to anglophone students.
- In 2nd year and 3rd year the culture courses are offered as options. Students may choose ONE option per semester.
It is not possible to take more than one option from the same UE.
For example, students may not take both Culture 3.1 and Culture 3.2.
