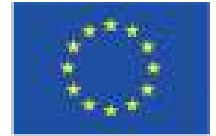

What is EUROSUD?



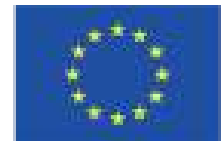

Career prospects

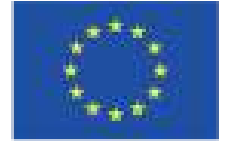
